Sniper Rifle Challenge 3rd Montana Championship 19<sup>th</sup> Century vs. 20<sup>th</sup> Century

19<sup>th</sup> Century Rifles NRA Black Powder Cartridge Rifle Silhouette rules apply.

Exposed hammer single shot rifles Introduced prior to 1896. Replicas permitted. Iron sights or scopes allowed.

## 19<sup>th</sup> Century Ammunition NRA BPCR Silhouette rules apply.

Lead alloy bullets only, black powder only. Cartridge introduced prior to 1896. 20<sup>th</sup> Century Rifles Civilian Marksmanship Program Vintage Sniper Rifle rules apply

Bolt action and semi-auto sniper rifles adopted by a nation's military prior to 1955. Replicas permitted. Iron sights or scopes (up to 10x or variables turned to 10x)

## 20<sup>th</sup> Century Ammunition Civilian Marksmanship Program Vintage Sniper rules apply.(basically)

Any safe factory or handload. FMJ bullets allowed. No armor piercing in silhouette match.

## **Courses of Fire:**

Saturday; 40 shot silhouette match using NRA rules. 10 shots each at, chickens 200m, pigs 300m, turkeys 385m, and rams 500m. Chickens fired at offhand, all other targets can be fired at from prone.

19<sup>th</sup> Century competitors can use crossed stick rest.

20<sup>th</sup> Century competitors can use sandbags, or sandbag atop ammo can or wooden block but only the forearm of the rifle can be rested. **No mechanical rests permitted. No shooting jackets or gloves permitted.** 

1<sup>st</sup> half of relay will be 7 minutes with unlimited sighters but 5 score shots must be fired in that time. Once competitor goes for score no more sighting shots are allowed.

2<sup>nd</sup> half of relay is 5 minutes with 5 score shots, no sighters. There will be a 30 second ready command prior to each half of the relay. Sunday; 30 shot mid-range paper match 4 sighters and 10 record shots each at 200, 300, and 600 yds

Each 2 person squad has 3 minute prep followed by 50 minutes for sighting and record shots.

Each target will be assigned 2 persons shooting and 2 persons pulling targets in the pits.

Same rules apply to rifles, ammunition, rests, shooting jackets and gloves.

Competitors can fire either one or both days. Separate awards and prizes for each day.

Competitors can switch between 19<sup>th</sup> Century and 20<sup>th</sup> Century matches, ie; You can shoot 20<sup>th</sup> Century on Saturday but 19<sup>th</sup> Century on Sunday or vice versa.

Entry fee will be \$25.00 per day.
